- Rounds:-** All Double or Single National rounds, New to Short Junior,
(N.B. Only the first round shot qualifies for National Record Status and team awards)
- Assembly :-** **9.30am sighters 9.45am Afternoon 1.45 pm sighters 2.00 pm** (*pm session times approximate*)
- Judges:-** Paula Golding, John Kember-Smith and Andy Turner.

- Closing Date:-** Sunday 12th July 2009 or when full – reserve list in operation

Awards:-

Individual - double and single rounds.
Team – single round
Awards for bow types
CU / REC / LB / BB

Archers may shoot any National round, but individual double and single rounds will only be rewarded as per table below. Those entered for single rounds compete for single awards, those entered for double rounds compete for double awards. Juniors may compete for higher age group awards (including shooting as adults for the longest distances.)

Team awards single round. For archers shooting a double round, the first round shot qualifies for any team award.

Senior recurve: 4 archers, **Senior compound:** 3 archers.

These teams must include both sexes or a Junior. Gents must shoot New or Long National, Ladies or Juniors must shoot National or above. These teams must also include 2 people shooting their longest distance for gender.

Longbow: 3 archers shooting National or above, must include both sexes (or Junior shooting their National round or above)

Junior recurve: 3 Juniors shooting their appropriate National round or above.

All awards according to entry: 1-3 Gold, 4-5 Gold & Silver, 6+ Gold, Silver & Bronze

- Entry Fees:-** **Double Round:** Adults: £ 9.00 Juniors: £ 7.00 **Single Round:** Adults £ 6.00 Juniors £ 5.00

- Parking:-** Please park in the school car park as directed. Overflow car park is available.

- Dress Code:-** GNAS dress regulations apply (Rule 307), white and/or dark green or registered club colours only please.

- Drug Testing:-** Record status shoots are liable for drug testing and all competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents are requested to sign the entry form to indicate that they agree to testing if their child is selected. Parents should explain the implications of drug testing to the younger archers.

- G.N.A.S. Cards:-** Current GNAS cards must be produced when booking in.

- Photography:-** Anyone wishing to take photographs or videos at the shoot will be required to register at the booking in desk on the day. Anyone wishing their image, or their children's image not to be taken should contact the organiser. Any images taken at the shoot should not be displayed with names without the persons involved or parents permission.

- Arrows:-** **Carbon-only arrows are not permitted as it is a multipurpose field.**
